General Information

In July 2002, the Coaching Task force published its final report and recommendations for improving the development, employment and deployment of coaches in England. Richard Caborn, the Minister for Sport, welcomed those recommendations and on 24 July 2002, Tessa Jowell, the Secretary for State, Culture, Media and Sport announced that the Government would invest more than 25 million over the following three years to implement them.
